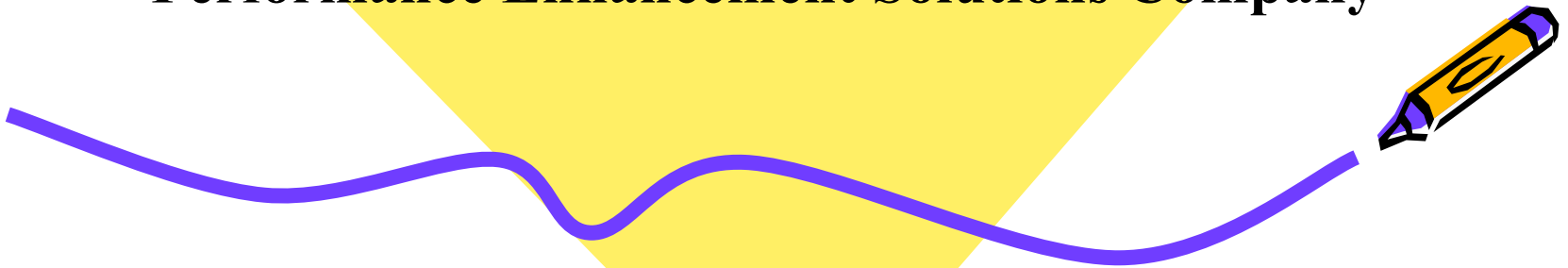


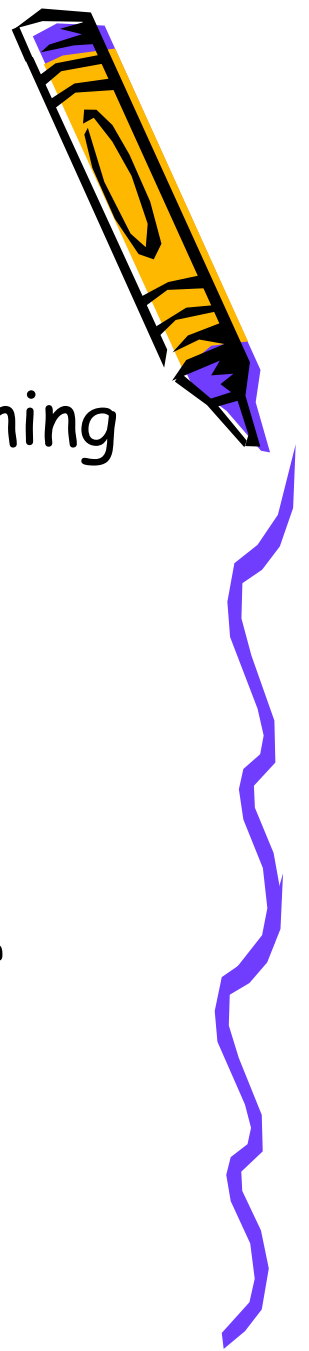

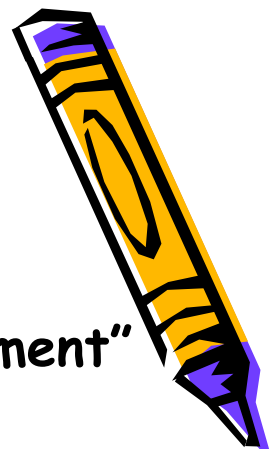
# NIS Sparta and HIV/AIDS

- 18,000 Police personnel have been trained so far in Delhi Police/UP Police/ Sikkim Police/CRPF/RPF.

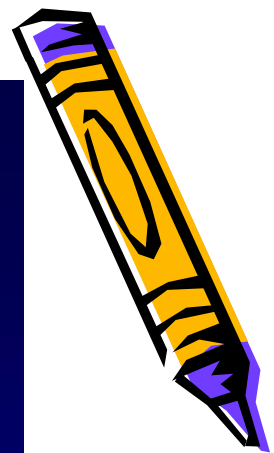
## Project Outreach

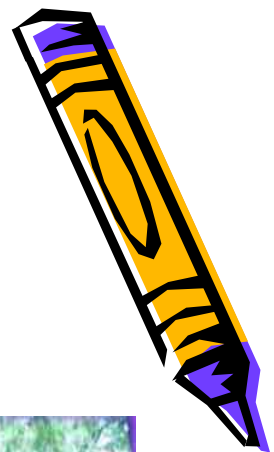
# IDEAH

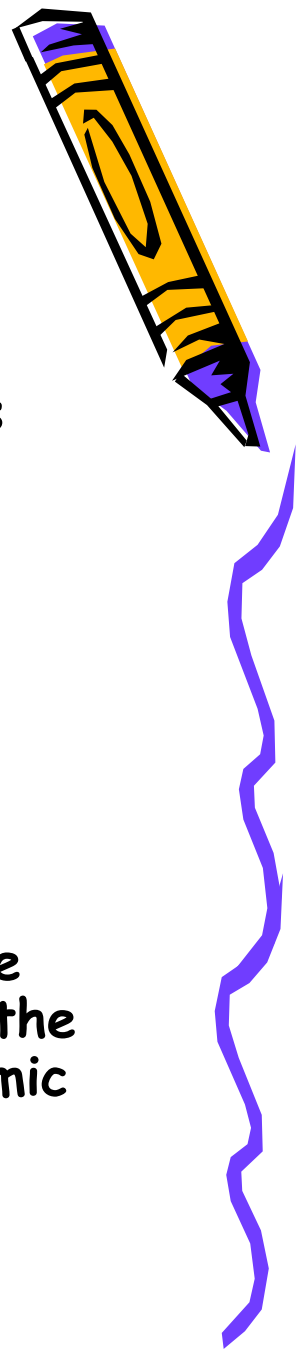
## Retailer Training

# ICT in HIV/AIDS



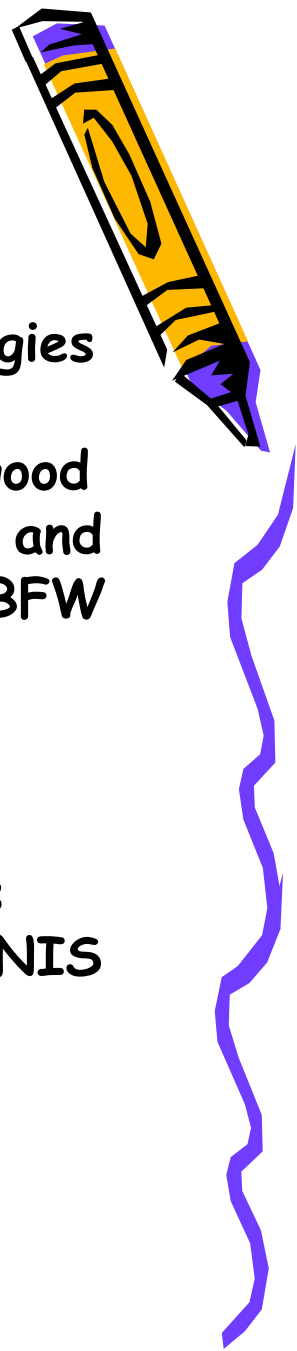
- **Mass Scale Awareness generation and Sensitization**

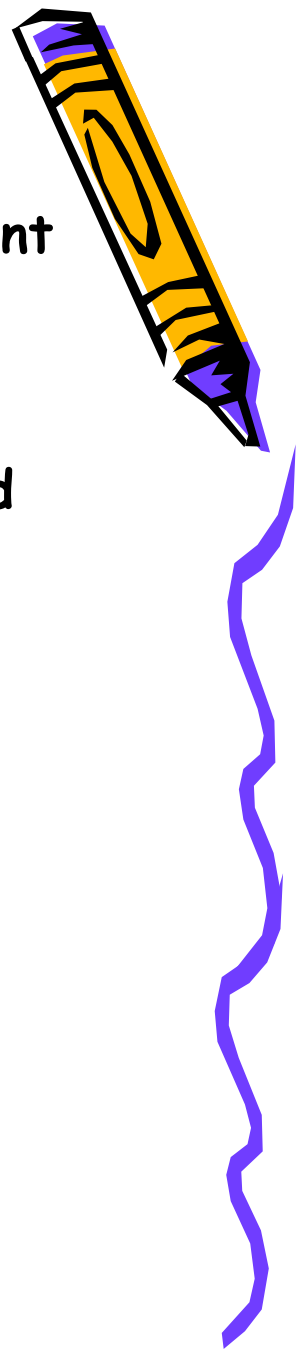
- Empowerment

Video conferencing, e-learning even through mobiles can make possible simultaneous, vernacular and continuous training possible with decreasing marginal costs. Rel-NIS academy

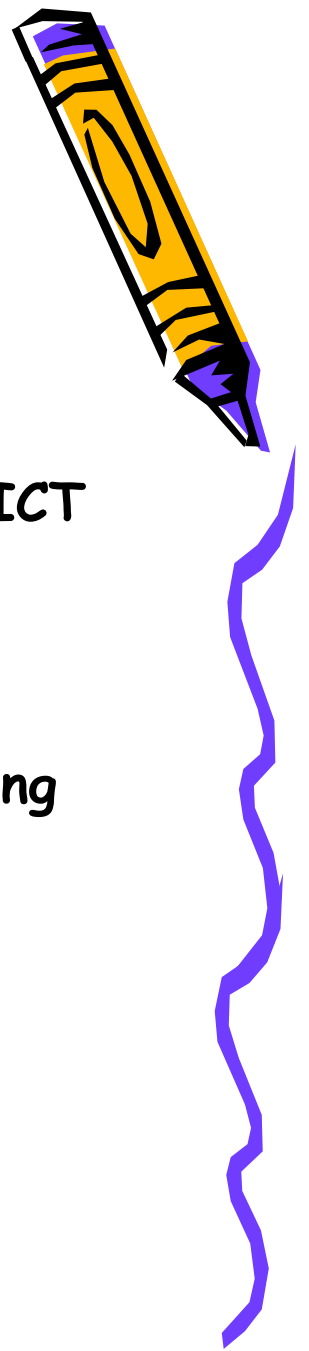




- Strengthening M&E and Manage Effective Procurement and Distribution
